Regulations for Workmen.

10 Oct 1826

Major J. CAMPBELL, Commandant.

1st. **Working Hours.**—The Prisoners are to work in dry weather from day light in the Morning 'til 8 O'Clock; from half past 8 until 11; and from 3 until Sunset.

The public work is to carried on every day except Sunday, on which day both Prisoners and Ticket of Leave Men are to attend Divine Service at 9 O'clock in the Military Barracks. In Rainy weather, the work will be regulated by Circumstances.
